



## **National Association of Elevator Contractors Certification Board Nominations**

### **Certification Board Purpose**

The NAEC Certification Board has been created to promote quality elevator technicians; accessibility and private residence lift technicians; elevator inspectors; and related technicians/inspectors through verification of formal education and examination of an individual's experience within the industry.

### **Certification Board Criteria**

As candidates are chosen for nomination to the NAEC Certification Board, they will be evaluated against the following criteria:

- 1) To be eligible for election to the Certification Board, they must have no less than ten (10) years' experience in the elevator industry.
- 2) Nominees and Board Members must be a duly authorized representative of their company.
- 3) Of the three nominees, two (2) members will represent the elevator industry at large and one (1) member will represent the Elevator Inspector category.
- 4) A Certification Board member must be able to devote a good deal of time to the duties of the position. Members will be appointed for a three (3) year commitment and may serve up to six (6) years if reappointed and willing.
