Certification Board Purpose

The NAEC Certification Board has been created to promote quality elevator technicians; accessibility and private residence lift technicians; elevator inspectors; and related technicians/inspectors through verification of formal education and examination of an individual's experience within the industry.

Certification Board Criteria

As candidates are chosen for nomination to the NAEC Certification Board, they will be evaluated against the following criteria:

- 1) To be eligible for election to the Certification Board, they must have no less than ten (10) years' experience in the elevator industry.
- 2) Nominees and Board Members must be duly authorized representative of their company.
- 3) Of the three nominees, two (2) members will represent the contractor category, and one (1) member will represent the elevator industry at large.
- 4) A Certification Board member must be able to devote a good deal of time to the duties of the position. Members will be appointed for a three (3) year commitment and may serve up to six (6) years if reappointed and willing.
